SCHOOL BEHAVIOUR POLICY 2024

We have attached our updated school behaviour policy as well as the child friendly version for you to look at. The children are aware that excellent behaviour is expected across all areas of school including lunchtimes. The children are expected to Shine and they know exactly what this means as each letter of the word Shine corresponds to an aspect of good behaviour. We have tried to keep our system as simple as possible so that all children have the opportunity to get it right. They are also aware of the sanctions if they do not follow the rules. Our children are not perfect but the vast majority of them respond well to the system with only the odd hiccup, which is to be expected!

Please take time to have a look at both versions and discuss with your child what they think.

PE KIT

Please could we remind parents/carers that in order to keep PE kit in line with school uniform the expectation is that children wear a red hoody or zip jacket and white t-shirt. These are available widely in supermarkets and also with the school logo from https://myclothing.com/yeadon-westfield-infant-school/7018.school. In addition children need to wear black leggings, jogging bottoms or shorts with plain black trainers (not fashion brands).
